This eco-friendly practice not only helps in organic waste management but also plays a vital role in enhancing soil fertility and agricultural productivity.

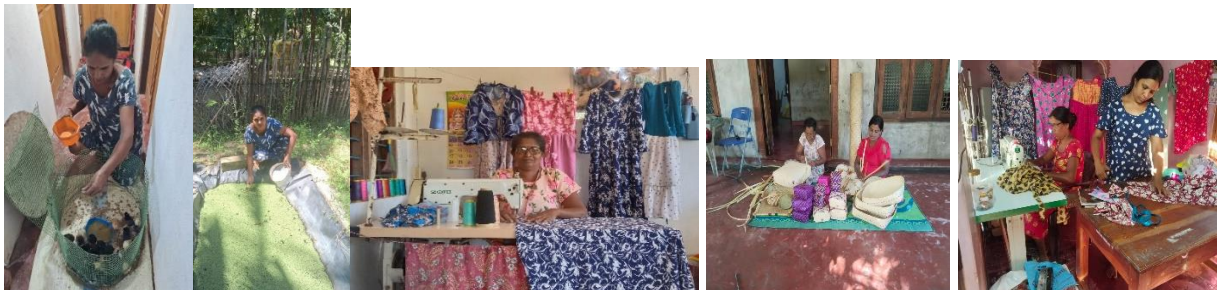


“MAGALIR MANRAM” MEETING
